Former pupil of Alberto Lysy and Liviu Prunaru at the Menuhin Academy in Gstaad and of Pierre Amoyal at the Lausanne Conservatory, Vlad Stanculeasa is currently leading a rich musical activity as a concertmaster, violin professor, chamber musician and soloist.

He is the leader of the Rotterdam Philharmonic Orchestra and the Gstaad Festival Orchestra as well as a violin professor at the Mozarteum University in Salzburg and the ESMUC Barcelona.

He is the founder and the artistic director of NUME Academy & Festival in Italy, a masterclass for highly advanced string players which offers tuition free courses and seminars, as well as chamber music and solo performance opportunities.

Stanculeasa plays a Lorenzo Storioni, Cremona, 1775 and the Jules Garcin Antonio Stradivari violin, Cremona 1731, kindly let to him by the Erasmus Foundation.
